Akron Safety Center	\$100,000	Investment of future replacement of aging Stubbs Justice Center.
Software/Hardware Upgrades	\$250,000	Computers, cameras, server equipment, security upgrades, phone upgrades, and various software solutions.
Maintain Appropriate Staffing	\$2,000,000	Maintain safe, appropriate staffing levels in Police.
Safety Forces Bond	\$200,000	Ongoing financing for Akron Police Department CAD system.
