City Issues Snow Emergency Parking Ban
Ban starts Immediately and Lasts Until 6:00 a.m. Saturday

December 26, 2012 (Akron, Ohio) - The City of Akron has issued a Snow Emergency Parking Ban for **ALL CITY STREETS** effective immediately. The ban is in effect until Saturday, December 29, 2012 at 6:00 a.m.

A Snow Emergency Parking Ban means the City has the power to tow cars parked on city streets if they impede the progress of snow clearing operations.

Snow parking bans are issued for the purpose of the public's safety and the efficiency of snow clearing efforts on city streets.

All cars should be removed from parking spots on city streets regardless of whether city crews are plowing main roads or residential side streets. Cars not moved may be towed by the City.
