

Shelter / Facility Disclaimer

1. **COST:** The user shall pay agreed upon cost to be determined upon final approval of the premises. Cost shall be paid by cash, certified check, money order, **VISA** or **MASTERCARD** only, payable to the City of Akron. **DUE BY 0/00/2014** Fee is refundable up to 30 Days before Permitted day. All refunds can take up to 45 days.
 2. The responsibility for crowd control discipline is assumed by the permit holder. All proceedings shall be orderly.
 3. This permit is for the **SHELTER ONLY**. The ball fields are permitted separately and it cannot be assumed that they are free for your use. To secure a ball field permit call 330-375-2857.
 4. Shelter is to be used only for the activities noted on the permit.
 5. The holder of this permit will be held responsible for damages to City property resulting from use therein.
 6. The holder shall indemnify and hold harmless the City of Akron, its officers, employees, agents and assigns from any claims for injury and/or damages to persons or property.
 7. The holder shall inspect the facility sit before use and determine its fitness for the permit use.
 8. **THE USE OF PROFANITY AND ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES IS PROHIBITED.**
 9. Permit holders are responsible for cleaning up debris (and restrooms) at the conclusion of each permit period.
 10. The use of City property is subject to all pertinent State Laws, City Ordinances and Health Department Regulations:
ORDINANCE #93.40 – FIRE GENERAL REGULATIONS:
 - A. No person shall kindle or maintain any fire or knowingly furnish the material for any fire or authorize any fir to be kindled or maintained within the limits of the City.
 - B. This section shall not apply to fires kindled or maintained within the limits of the City for the purpose of cooking for human consumption if the following requirements are compiled with:
 1. Only charcoal, wood, liquefied petroleum gas or natural gas shall be used;
 2. The fire and the fuel that has been added to the fire shall be contained within a grill or device that is designed to contain a cooking fire;
 3. The fire and extra fuel shall be kept a minimum of **15 FEET AWAY FROM ALL STRUCTURES** and,
 4. The size, conditions, means of maintaining and other aspects of the fire, containment device and resulting smoke shall not present a safety hazard or nuisance.
 - C. A fire kindled or maintained within the limits of the City for the purpose of cooking food for human consumption may be ordered ceased if violations of this chapter exist, or if a safety hazard or a nuisance exists.
 - D. This section shall not apply to fires kindled or maintained within the limits of the City for the purpose of providing heat for outdoor workers and strikers if the requirements of Ohio Administrative Code chapter 3745-19 are complied with.**ORDIANCE # 113-1983**
Golf prohibited in City Parks.
ORDINANCE 231-1973
 - A. All dogs must be leashed and under control at all times.

11. The permit holder must have this permit with him/her upon their arrival and for the duration of their reservation.
 12. Site hours of operation for all Akron City Parks areas and picnic shelters are sunrise to sunset.
 13. The user is confined to areas specified it the contract **ONLY**.
 14. Failure to comply with all the above may result in permanent cancellation for permitted usage.
