Project Description: This project consists of approximately 600 feet of roadway improvements between S. Main Street and Firestone Parkway. Improvements will include abandoning the existing roadway alignment and constructing a 32' wide commercial asphalt pavement with 6" x 18" concrete curb, concrete sidewalks, concrete aprons, and inlets along the new alignment. Improvements also include reconstruction of the existing 8" sanitary sewer and existing 6" water main.

Bidders must use the prepared forms provided therefore which include compliance with Chapter 34 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Akron, Ohio 1993, regarding public contracts, as none other will be accepted.

Except as provided in Section 102.07 of The City of Akron, Construction and Materials Specifications, 2008 Edition, each proposal must be accompanied by a certified check in the sum of 5% of bids on a solvent bank, or a bid bond in like amount, acceptable to the City of Akron, as a guarantee, that if the proposal is accepted, a contract will be entered into.

Bids may be held by the City of Akron for a period not to exceed ninety (90) days from the date of the opening of Bids for the purpose of reviewing the Bids and investigating the qualifications of Bidders, prior to awarding the contract.

Except as provided in Section 103.05 of The City of Akron, Construction and Materials Specifications, 2008 Edition, the bidder to whom the contract is awarded will be required to furnish a bond in the sum of 100% of contract price for the faithful performance of the contract.

The Director of Public Service reserves the right to reject any or all bids, and to waive informalities.
