Join us on **Friday, March 20, 2015**, as the Honorable Mayor Donald L. Plusquellic presents his State of the City Address. In this annual address, Mayor Plusquellic will detail the municipal achievements of 2014 and talk about current and future issues and projects.

In 2011, Plusquellic was re-elected to a seventh term and currently is in his 29th year as Mayor of the City of Akron. The city's longest-serving mayor is a life-long resident of Akron. He became the 59th Mayor of Akron in February 1987, after serving with distinction for 13 years on Akron City Council, including three years as president from 1984-1987. Citizens of Ward 9 first elected him to council as their representative in 1973, when he was 24 years old.

Mayor Plusquellic has devoted more than 40 years to public service in a career highlighted by great leadership successes locally and nationally. A graduate of Akron's Kenmore High School, Plusquellic attended the University of Pittsburgh School of Engineering and graduated from Bowling Green State University School of Business. He earned his JD from The University of Akron School of Law.
