## 2020 TRASH & RECYCLING HOLIDAY SCHEDULE

Trash collection will be delayed one day on these holidays:

### “Rules & Regulations”

Place your household trash and recyclables on the curb only in City-issued carts.

- Only City-issued carts will be serviced.
- You must bag all garbage, including grass and animal waste, and place in your trash cart.
- Do not overfill your trash cart. LIDS MUST BE SHUT FOR COLLECTION to eliminate trash falling out of the container onto the street as the truck’s mechanical arm is lifting the cart.
- Put your trash and recycle carts on the curb after 4:30 p.m. the day before collection or earlier than 4:30 a.m. on the day of collection.
- Please remove your empty carts by 6:00 p.m. after serviced on collection day. Place empty container(s) up against side or rear of house.
- Place your trash and recycle carts about 3 feet apart. Also, please leave carts 3 feet away from any other obstruction, including vehicles, to assist with collection.
- Items not permitted in your trash and recycle carts are: hazardous waste, roofing material, concrete, plaster, dirt, sand, gravel, bricks, drywall and demolition/construction materials. These items will not be collected.

**Trash collection will not be delayed on any other holiday.**

**Weekly Large Item Pick Up:** On your normal collection day, the City will pick up bulk items such as furniture, dressers, mattresses, couches, chairs, bookcases, house doors, storm doors, windows, bicycles, TVs (19" and larger), tires (8 per year), and appliances. Wood, branches, brush, carpeting, and fencing will also be collected weekly but must be bundled/rolled, tied, and no longer than 4 feet long. For questions about Large Item Pick Ups, please call 3-1-1 (or 330-375-2311). YOU DO NOT NEED TO CALL AHEAD TO SCHEDULE A WEEKLY LARGE ITEM PICK UP.

**Special Bulk Pick Up:** The City offers weekly large item collections as part of our curbservice. The only time you must schedule a special bulk pick up is when you will be placing extra bags, or 32 gal., or 45 gal. cans on the curb for service. If there is no bulk stop scheduled, these items will not be collected and may be tagged. Lawn and leaf bags must be scheduled for pick up as well. Please note: 20 cubic yard limit on special bulk pick ups. Customers are allowed 3 Special Bulk Pick Ups per calendar year on your normal collection day. PLEASE NOTE THAT YOU MUST CALL ONE DAY AHEAD TO SCHEDULE A SPECIAL BULK PICK UP: Call 3-1-1 (or 330-375-2311).


