116 WPCLF CONTRACT REQUIREMENTS**

The following section is a supplement to CMS General Provisions 100.

WPCLF CONTRACT REQUIREMENTS

116.01 VIOLATING FACILITIES

The CONTRACTOR agrees to comply with all applicable standards, orders, or requirements under Section 306 of the Clean air act, 42 USC 1857(h), Section 508 of the Clean Water act, 33 USC 1368, Executive order 11738, and EPA regulations, 40 CFR Part 32, which prohibits the use under non-exempt Federal Contracts, grants, or loans of facilities included on the EPA List of Violating Facilities.

116.02 REQUIREMENT FOR UTILIZATION OF SMALL BUSINESSES IN RURAL AREAS (SBRA)

This Project is subject to the EPA policy of encouraging the participation of small businesses in rural areas. It is EPA policy that recipients of EPA financial assistance awards utilize the services of small businesses in rural areas (SBRAs), to the maximum extent practicable. The objective is to assure that such small business entities are afforded the maximum practicable opportunity to participate as Subcontractors, suppliers, and otherwise in EPA-awarded financial assistance programs. This policy applies to all contracts and subcontracts for supplies, construction, and services under EPA grants or cooperative agreements (including without limitation this Contract and any contracts or subcontracts entered into by CONTRACTOR or any Subcontractor). Small purchases are also subject to this policy.

116.03 CONTINUOUS TREATMENT PROVISIONS

Federal regulations prohibit by-passing of any sewage during construction operations. The CONTRACTOR will be responsible for providing any required temporary facilities, piping, etc., necessary to complete the Project without any by-passing and continuous treatment must be provided at the same level during construction as existed prior to construction.

116.04 PERMITS

Unless otherwise previously or subsequently specified, the CONTRACTOR shall procure and pay for all permits, licenses, and approvals necessary for the execution of this Contract. The CONTRACTOR shall comply with all laws, ordinance rules, orders and regulations relating to the performance of the Work required to complete their Contract.

116.05 WPCLF CHANGE ORDER FORM

All Change Orders for the Project must be executed on the WPCLF/WSRLA Change Order Form. This Form and instructions are found in the Project Forms and Information section of the Bid Book Volume One.

116.06 AMERICAN IRON AND STEEL REQUIREMENT:

The CONTRACTOR shall comply with all federal requirements applicable to the loan for the Project (including those imposed by the 2014 Appropriations Act and related SRF Policy Guidelines) which the CONTRACTOR understands includes, among other requirements, that all of the iron and steel products used in the Project are to be produced in the United States ("American Iron and Steel

Requirement") unless (i) the CONTRACTOR has requested and obtained a waiver from the Agency pertaining to the Project or (ii) the finance authority providing the loan for the Project has otherwise advised the CONTRACTOR in writing that the American Iron and Steel Requirement is not applicable to the Project.

116.07 TESTING SERVICES

The CONTRACTOR shall appoint, employ, and pay for specified testing services as defined in and as required by the applicable Contract Documents.

Testing does not relieve CONTRACTOR from performing the Work in accordance with the Contract Documents.
